<p>New South Wales</p> <p>http://www.olgr.nsw.gov.au/olgr_default.asp</p>	<p>Online RSA training is NOT accepted in New South Wales venues.</p> <p>A Liquor Administration Board (LAB) approved certificate is the only one accepted in NSW.</p> <p>For class details go to: www.cftnsw.com.au or call 1300 661 205</p>
<p>Victoria</p> <p>http://www.justice.vic.gov.au/alcohol</p>	<p>Nationally-recognised online RSA training is NOT accepted in Victoria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • for licensees or staff working with packaged liquor in bottle shops and supermarkets; • when applying for a new liquor licence (ie you will be the licensee); • working at a venue which has on its licence a condition that requires staff to have an RSA certificate; and • in venues that are open after 1 am and have amplified music. <p>The RSA certificate approved by the Director of Liquor Licensing is only available through in-class training. <p>Queensland</p> <p>http://www.olgr.qld.gov.au/</p>	<p>Queensland OLGR Training Course Certificate is required for all staff to work in Queensland within 30 days of starting employment .</p> <p>Staff who have a nationally recognised or current other State or Territory RSA certificate can do the OLGR approved RSA Bridging Course online www.cftqld.com.au)</p> <p>If you hold a Queensland Liquor Licensing certificate and need to renew it, you must undertake the full OLGR RSA Training course certificate, NOT the bridging course-there is NO refresher course approved in Queensland.</p> <p>Volunteers serving or supplying alcohol will not be required to hold a current RSA training course certificate if performing duties under one of the following licence categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • community club licence • community other licence • community liquor permit • restricted liquor permit. <p>In these instances, the licensee/permittee must take reasonable steps to ensure there is a person with current OLGR RSA training to supervise the volunteers.</p> <p>OLGR RSA Online you get 2 certificates: OLGR RSA training course certificate and a national RSA certificate which is valid in some states & territories for those who travel (always check each state's requirements). The national unit is NOT suitable for RMLV or Queensland participants.</p>
